- **6. Description of content:** The BSMI intends to adopt the revised standard, CNS 11728:2016, of fire-retardant paints for buildings as the inspection standard. New requirements include volatile organic compound (VOC) content, limits of hazardous heavy metals and labelling. The products will be required to comply with the revised standard beginning 1 July 2018.
- **7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:** Consumer information, labelling; Protection of human health or safety; Protection of consumers' safety
- **8. Relevant documents:** The Commodity Inspection Act, CNS 11728
