<b>6. Description of content:</b> The third-generation mobile communications (3G) service will be terminated in December 2018. Due to the requirement for CSFB, 3G network will still exist in the mobile broadband (4G) network as heterogeneous networks. In other words, the third generation mobile communication technology can provide services by using the frequency of mobile broadband services. In order to meet the development needs of domestic mobile broadband services, the NCC refers to relevant international technical standards, and the arrangement of "Technical Specifications for Base Station Radio Frequency Equipment of Mobile Broadband Business", and combine IS 2035, IS 2036 and IS 2037 into this regulation.
